
Joe Hughes has been Chairman and CEO of Shipowners Claims Bureau, Inc. (SCB), the New York-based manager of the American P&I Club, for nearly 27 years. He joined SCB in 1995 from London where he was chairman of global marine at Jardine Insurance Brokers, a major Lloyd's intermediary.

A Liverpool-born Welshman – and now a US citizen – Joe graduated in law from Balliol College, Oxford and was thereafter called to the Bar of England and Wales, serving his pupillage in a leading barristers' chambers specializing in maritime law. Joe began his marine insurance career at the Steamship Mutual P&I club in 1977, and subsequently worked for the Gard club in both Norway and London before joining Jardine's.

Since Joe's arrival at SCB, the American Club has emerged as a full-service insurance provider, offering P&I, hull and related lines of cover, with a presence throughout the world.

A former president of the Maritime Association of the Port of New York and New Jersey, Joe continues to serve on its board. He is the current chairman of the North American Marine Environment Protection Association (NAMEPA) and chairman of its international coordinating body, INTERMEPA. A former chairman of the Association of Average Adjusters of the United States, Joe also serves on the board of both the American Club and its Cyprus-based subsidiary,

the American Club (Europe). He is also a member of committees of the American Bureau of Shipping and of Lloyd's Register of Shipping.

Gary Cross

President and Chief Executive Officer Maher Terminals LLC



Gary began his career at Maher Terminals in 1978 in the company's safety department. From the safety department, he moved into the operations division of the company where he spent the next 17 years. After rising through the ranks in operations, Gary was promoted to Vice President and General Manager of the Tripoli Street Terminal in 1994. Soon after, he moved into the sales and marketing department in 1996 as Vice President and was made Senior Vice President in 2004. In 2009, he was promoted to the position of Executive Vice President, and in April 2013, was appointed President & CEO of Maher Terminals and Maher Terminals Holding Corp., the marine terminal that Maher developed in Prince Rupert, British Columbia.

Maher Terminals operates the largest privately held marine terminal in North America, loading and unloading 2 million containers annually for its longstanding shipping line customers, while employing nearly 1,500 International Longshoremen's Association members and management staff. Having been born and raised in Newark, Gary's philosophy that the company must be good neighbors to the communities surrounding the port remains as strong as ever. The community stewardship fostered under Gary's leadership is evident in Maher's commitment to sustainability principles. Maher has dramatically upgraded its container handling equipment to reduce emissions by 62%, and uses 750,000 fewer gallons of diesel fuel annually. With respect to emissions, Maher mapped a plan to be Net Zero by 2040, a full decade ahead of the Paris Agreement.

Gary is a board member of the Metropolitan Marine Maintenance Contractors' Association and Long Beach Container Terminal, and he is a former Director of the Maritime Association of the Port of New York – New Jersey. The Port Authority of New York & New Jersey selected him to be an inaugural member of the Port Authority's Council on Port Performance. In 2011, Gary received the Maritime, Industry, and Government Good Scout Award from the Boy Scouts of America, Patriots Path Council, and in 2020, the Association of Bi-State Motor Carriers presented Gary with its first Jeffrey A. Bader Memorial Award. In February, business journal NJBIZ named Gary to its 2022 Power 100 list.

As an industry consultant, he advises an FMC-filed discussion agreement composed of the six container terminal operators in Port of New York/New Jersey as well as oversees the project activities for its nonprofit corporation, Sustainable Terminal Services, Inc. (STS). In this capacity, he was instrumental in developing a port wide RFID-truck identification system and a first in the nation port wide information portal providing cargo visibility and a reservation function to pick up and drop off containers.

A proven shipping line executive approaching 50 years of experience, Mike began his career at Moore McCormack Lines. He went on to NYK Lines, where he became Senior Vice President of North America sales, and later Senior Vice President of liner management, responsible for route management, alliance relationships, commercial activities including contracting and compliance. While at NYK, he was the company's senior representative at all conference and agreement meetings. Mike was also instrumental in leading the company in its strategic response to the Ocean Shipping Reform act of 1998 and was a member of NYK's North American Board of Directors. From 2007 until his retirement, he was Senior Vice President, Business Development for NYK's terminal operating subsidiary, Ceres Terminals Inc., which gave Mike a complete perspective on cargo transportation operations.

A passionate advocate for the industry, Mike has devoted significant time and expertise to industry non-profit organizations, including the Containerization & Intermodal Institute (CII), the Foreign Commerce Club as well as the Maritime Association, where, as the most recent president, Mike was involved in expanding the constituency of and promoting the organization as the primary advocate for maritime activities in the New York harbor.



Roger Guenther

Executive Director Port Houston



Roger Guenther is the Executive Director of Port Houston, which includes the region's largest breakbulk facility and two of the most efficient and fastest-growing container terminals in the nation. Port Houston is also the local sponsor of the Houston Ship Channel, currently ranked number one for waterborne tonnage. Guenther oversees all operations at Port Houston's public facilities, handling a diverse range of imports and exports including container, general cargo, breakbulk and bulk commodities. Additionally, Guenther is responsible for advocating for ongoing improvements and maintenance of the Houston Ship Channel (HSC) in partnership with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Recently, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers awarded Port Houston \$142,515,000 as part of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, which will be utilized to complete a portion of the Houston Ship Channel Expansion –Project 11. Port Houston and the more than 200 private terminals along the HSC together support 3.2 million jobs and \$802 billion in annual economic value nationwide. Guenther was named Executive Director of Port Houston in January 2014. Before being named Executive Director, he served as Deputy Executive Director of Operations and was responsible for all container and breakbulk cargo operations, management and construction of capital development projects, facility and asset maintenance and real estate interests. Guenther's 34 years of hands-on experience allows him to manage Port Houston with a unique skillset and perspective, and a leadership track record that speaks for itself. Guenther currently serves on numerous boards and committees. In 2021, Guenther was appointed by Governor Gregg Abbott to the board of the Gulf Coast Protection

District. He also serves on the Texas Department of Transportation's Texas Freight Advisory Committee, the Port Authority Advisory Committee, the Board of Visitors of Texas A&M University at Galveston, Texas A&M Transportation Institute (TTI) Advisory Council, the Port Terminal Railroad Association, the Greater Houston Port Bureau and the Board of Directors of the National Association of Waterfront Employees. Guenther's awards and honors include the 2018 Most Admired CEO-Houston Business Journal, 2018 Humanitarian Award (Philanthropic Male)-Latino Learning Center and 2017 Bronze Award Recipient-Houston International Seafarers. Guenther earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering from Texas A&M University in College Station, TX

Anthony V. Marino, Executive Vice President of The Marino Group, is the first posthumous award recipient. When Anthony passed away in August 2021 at 59 following a courageous battle with a long illness the industry lost its "Gentle Giant."

Beloved and respected by all, Anthony joined his brother Vincent at The Marino Group upon graduation from New York University. While Vincent runs the operation from the group's Charleston, SC, headquarters, Anthony remained in New York City and handled the all-important customer services responsibilities. They would be seen together introducing new services to clients and would-be business partners or at industry events The Marino Group supported enthusiastically.

"He made me a better person," says Vincent of his brother. "His instincts were right on and his contributions to the maritime industry were significant." Anthony was fastidious, whether balancing the needs of competing clients or selecting the wine for a customer dinner.
